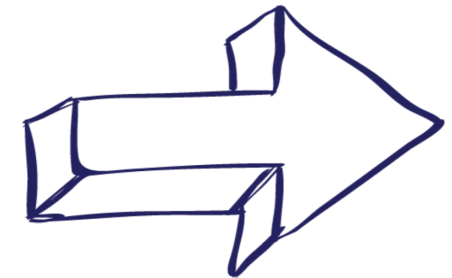


Pray 2020
